

**Era Fashion Committee member Pegge Blinco  
models a 1930 “At Home Entertaining Outfit” to achieve the  
“Model A Era Image”**



Pegge is wearing an aqua print chiffon top,  $\frac{3}{4}$  length pointed edged sleeve with asymmetrical hems. Ball fringe trims the neckline and sleeves. It is an original era garment. Purchased from an estate sale. Her dyed-to-match camisole is also aqua.

Her black pants are reproduction in the lounging style, which was popular in 1930. The top and pants constitute the major garment. The camisole is considered coordinated apparel.

She is wearing reproduction long black beads and original black jet earrings. She is also wearing original black jet graduated beads that belonged to her mother. Her Bracelet is also reproduction.

Pegge’s aqua slippers are original “Daniel Greene” slippers found at a Swap Meet. Her seamless nylon hose are considered reproduction.

To complete this “Model A Era Image,” Pegge could have carried an era magazine or a tray possibly from 1930 to finish the picture she is creating.

No headwear is required to go with the “At Home Entertaining Outfit.” Pegge could have had an era hairstyle and make-up.
