☐ Inspect radiator hose	☐ Check tail lamp mounting screws
☐ Inspect / adjust fan belt	☐ Clean battery cable clamps
☐ Inspect fan	☐ Check battery ground connections
☐ Inspect engine compartment	☐ Check battery box tie down
☐ Lubrication	☐ Check safety fuse
☐ Front spindles upper / lower	☐ Inspect all wiring and connections
☐ Steering tie-rod / drag link	☐ Check battery electrolyte level
☐ Front brake camshafts	☐ Check battery output
☐ Front spring shackles/ check tightness	☐ Wheels and Tires
☐ Front shock links	☐ Tire pressure 32 p.s.i.
☐ Rear spring shackles / check tightness	☐ Examine tires for cracks, wear, damage
☐ Rear shock links	☐ Toe-in
☐ Rear brake camshafts	☐ Inspect front wheel bearings for looseness, spin
☐ Rear brake wheel bearings	☐ Check all lug nuts – 55 lbs torque
☐ U-joint	☐ Inspect king pins
☐ Service brake cross shaft	Rear axle nut torque – 100 lbs min
☐ Emergency brake cross shaft	□ Brakes
☐ Brake / clutch pedal bushing	☐ Inspect all cotter pins
☐ Water pump	☐ Inspect service brake / emergency cross shaft
☐ Throw out bearing	☐ Inspect all linkages, rods, and return springs
☐ Transmission fluid level	☐ Check one front brake for internal wear – if necessary check all
☐ Differential fluid level	☐ Adjust brakes as required
☐ Steering fluid level	☐ Other items
☐ Overdrive fluid level	☐ Test windshield wiper
☐ Accelerator control shifts	☐ Check wiper blade rubber
☐ Distributor / Spark plugs	☐ Test signals / emergency flashers if equipped
☐ Check / inspect points	☐ Tighten spring U-bolts front / rear
☐ Set point gap .018" to .022"	☐ Lubricate door strake plates / dovetails
☐ Lubricate shaft (oil filler)	☐ Drain fuel sediment bowl
☐ Lubricate cam	☐ Check carburetor / manifold bolts
☐ Inspect plug wires	☐ Clean carburetor filter screen
☐ Clean and regap plugs .035"	☐ Inspect fuel system for leaks
☐ Clean distributor body, lid, rotor, and inspect for cracks	☐ Adjust clutch free travel
☐ Check coil polarity and output	☐ Clean horn commutator, oil bearings, adjust
☐ Set ignition timing	☐ Check entire exhaust system for leaks
☐ Compression check	☐ Check exhaust clamp
☐ #1 Cylinder	☐ Check manifold bolt torque – 45 lbs
#2 Cylinder	☐ Check springs for cracks or broken / excessively worn shackles
☐ #3 Cylinder	☐ Repack upper ends of shock links as required
#4 Cylinder	
☐ Electrical system	
☐ Test headlights, tail lights, stop, and dash	Owners should ensure their crankcase oil is changed, filters re-
☐ Wipe out headlight switch	placed if so equipped and they should drain and flush radiator with clean water. Add Redline Water Wetter to radiator when filling.
